Here's wishing you and your families a Happy Easter. If fortunate enough, perhaps you had the opportunity to celebrate this holiday with your families.

Last month we reported to you the success the Detachment achieved, under the leadership of Marine Al Kessler, while manning a booth at the Optimist Club's Seaside Boat Show. Boosted by that success, Al obtained a copy of the Ocean City 2010 Official Visitor's Guide which contained the calendar of events to be held at the Convention Center through June of 2010.
